Reflection

<u>Lighting the Hope Candle (Responsive):</u>

Reflection

Lighting of the Peace Candle (Responsive):

All: God's peace is like a river that moves and flows with energy for change, washing away the old habits that harm and washing us anew in readiness for God's Holy Spirit.

One: We light the candle of peace, like a flowing river that washes us anew, making room for the

Spirit of God.

All: Creator God, maker of heaven and earth, as your light continues to break into the darkness of this Advent season, we join with all creation in longing for your peace like a river. Let your light of peace wash over us like an ever-flowing stream, washing away what dams our lives, and washing anew with the force that brings change and makes room for the life-giving presence of your Holy Spirit. Amen.

Reflection

<u>Lighting of the Joy Candle (Responsive):</u>

All: God's Joy is like a wilderness, wild and untamed, blossoming promised new life amid the harsh reality of our world.

One: We light the candle of joy, like the wilderness, God's abundant goodness and presence, alive and active among us.

All: Creator God, maker of heaven and earth, as your light continues to break into the darkness of this Advent season, we join with all creation in longing to rejoice with singing like the wilderness. We long for a world redeemed by you, where gladness and joy spring up amid sorrow and sighing. Help us not to settle for conditional happiness that changes with the season but let us take root in the true joy of your presence, wild, untamed, generous, life giving and free, blossoming among us. Amen.
