# 'Tis So Sweet to Trust in Jesus 350

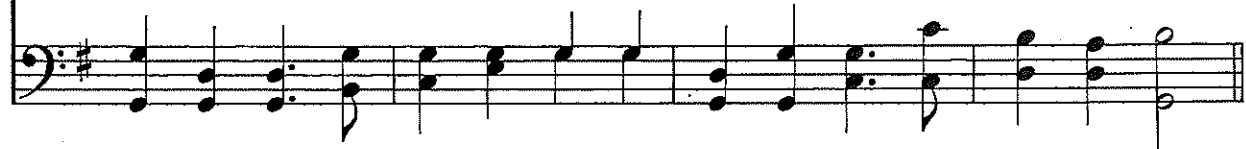
*Trust in God; trust also in Me. John 14:1*
